Used extensively for the storage of palletised goods within warehouses, available in numerous configurations:

- **Wide aisle pallet racking** used with conventional lift trucks for most applications.
- Narrow aisle pallet racking (VNA) increased storage capacity allowing access to all pallets, operating within aisles of 1600mm using bespoke lift trucks.
- **Drive- in racking** high density storage based on First In Last Out (FILO) principles.
- **Double deep pallet racking** allows 2 pallets to be loaded into a rack, one behind the other.
- Push back racking allows palletised goods to be loaded/retrieved from one pallet face up to six pallets deep using specially designed carts, based on Last In – First Out (LIFO) principles. Once the pallet has been retrieved, the loaded pallet behind rolls forward allowing high stock rotation.

- Pallet live where pallets are loaded onto gravity roller lanes allowing high density of storage based on First-In First Out (FIFO) principles.
- **Multi –tier** is an introduction of floor levels between racking to Increase picking locations.
- **Anti-collapse** is guarding installed to the rear of racking to provide protection to personnel working within the vicinity.

Cantilever racking uprights are bespoke design ideally suited to accommodate long awkward products such as timber, steel tubes or sheets, moulded extrusions, etc.

All uprights are pre-drilled to enable support arms to be bolted into position. Products of various heights can be stored within each bay, as well as arms being easily replaced in the event of damage.

Vertical racking is a simple yet effective system for the upright storage of lengthy items such as copper tube, timber, steel angles, plastic extrusions and other long items.

Shelving systems are an extremely versatile, cost effective storage medium, ideal for industrial, retail and commercial environments, accommodating various types of products ranging from small to large bulky items.

All systems are accompanied with a varying range of accessories i.e. shelf dividers, plastic drawers, mesh shelves, lockable doors, etc, which can be configured to suit individual applications.

Shelving systems offer the following benefits:

- Easily adjustable.

- Mobile ideal for areas where access or space is limited.
- **Multi tier** is an introduction of floor levels between shelving to Increase picking locations.
